Principal- Let's start the meeting out with some great news! Ewa Makai Middle School will be awarded the Purple Star Norbert Award on December 14th. Kudos to everyone for making Cheer-Off a success. Senator Fevella and Representative Alcos were able to join us for the event and give out special recognition to Mrs. Diana Agor for her retirement and Mr. Ariel Villanueva for being CK Teacher of the Year for 2024. Also, VP Gadach was able to sneak in during the announcements to tell the whole school that Principal Sanders was awarded the 2024 NAESP National Distinguished Principal of the Year for Leeward District! Thank you to Mr. Simeon and Mr. Villanueva for having a tree planting ceremony on November 23 where they planted 4 new fruit trees in our back field area.
